Innovations in the digital care of the elderly :Technical, ethical and legal aspects

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Presentation

In this workshop we will discuss some of the most innovative aspects in the care of the elderly, both in terms of mobilized technologies (NICT) and in terms of structuring and running health care or life care.

In the wake of the "My Health 2022" strategy and with the will to share knowledge and expertise at the European level, it is necessary to question the gerontechnologies and to cross the scientific and technical problems that they carry with the ethical questions and the legal rights they raise according to patients' rights and the coherence of their care pathways.

In this respect, the different uses of digital in geriatrics will be considered, from the use of connected objects, the design of organizational devices to support the continuity of care pathways (even though they are increasingly complex and multidisciplinary for older people who are dependent or presenting a loss of autonomy) as well as the innovation in geriatric research.

The debates will be supported by the presence of recognized specialists from the Geriatrics Department of the University Hospital of Toulouse as well as experienced lawyers who are deeply involved in the development of these new technologies.

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
